Spotlight: local artist Marcie Stammen

For this issue, we chose to feature local artist Marcie Stammen, who played a significant role in this year's Gala. Marcie is a local Catholic artist who has created a workshop called "Sacred Art, Healing & Prayer" that helps people pray through art. Recently, we sat down with Marcie to discuss her background and why she founded this wonderful ministry.

Marcie, why don't we start with you sharing a bit about yourself and your background?

I studied art & design in college, worked in the field for a few years afterward, then spent 25 years to raise our eight kids. It was full-time and messy, yet beautiful - and those years taught me about patience, creativity and what it means to grow as a Christian woman. Eventually, I returned to painting, not because I had it all figured out, but because art felt like a place that I could connect with God, myself and others.

What inspired you to pursue Sacred Art, Healing, and Prayer?


I can't pinpoint a single moment, but rather a series of nudges from the Holy Spirit: being moved by hymns, scripture, saints, and inspired moments. Moments when painting with the help God opened a heart and moved the viewer to tears; co-creating with God. The Gala was one of those moments, painting live in front of people pushed me out of my comfort zone, but also taught me that vulnerability often opens the door to connection and healing.

Who are your painting workshops designed for? Can someone with little artistic experience take part?

Absolutely! Sacred Art Workshops are for anyone who is curious, seeking a place to rest, reflect, and find God in colors and texture. You don't need fancy skills. I design them so people of all levels feel welcome. The goal isn't perfect technique; the goal is progress, peace, and encountering God through the creative process.

Finding my way to God through art

For me, Sacred Art is less about the outcomes and more about finding God in the messy, beautiful spaces in between. When I offered to paint live at the Gala, I won't lie, I was kicking myself and wondering what I was thinking! "I can't do a live painting!" I thought, "Marcie, you have never created a painting in front of a crowd before!" So I practiced twice ahead of time to be sure I could finish it in under three hours, but I was still extremely nervous. The turning point came when I remembered my own advice: *invite God into the process*. Once I prayed and surrendered to Him, the anxiety lifted. I was able to relax, enjoy the moment, and let the painting unfold as a form of prayer. What felt like a leap of faith became a beautiful success and a reminder that God works through our weakness. It wasn't just about painting the image of Christ; it was about surrender, trust, and stepping forward even when I felt like I didn't have what it takes.



to think He prefers it that way. Painting has become a way of lifting my heart to God, and I've seen how that same process can bless others. Through Sacred Art, Sacred Art Workshops and live painting events, I've had the joy of watching people encounter Christ in a new way.
